Each InfoTrac PowerPack is a subject focused collection of full-text periodicals selected by Gale to fit a subject niche to support a unique category of researcher—environmentalists, business people, fine arts researchers, gardeners, home improvement, travelers, and more. Some InfoTrac PowerPacks also contain unique reference content and are marked with a check. The PowerPacks have the same user interface and functionality as *General OneFile* and *Academic OneFile* and are cross-searchable.
